Andrew (Andy) Cunningham began his career in the water and wastewater storage industry in 1970 as a crew laborer in Sioux Falls, SD. After a year, he was promoted to Service Technician, and three years later to Service Supervisor, responsible for managing and scheduling for Service Technicians.

In 1975, Andy started his own business, Harvestore Construction, a subcontractor for bolted tank construction. Over the next six years, he had exclusive contracts with Dakota Harvestore in South Dakota, Platte Valley Harvestore in Nebraska, and Siouxland Harvestore in Iowa. Under his management, two construction crews were installing 55-65 agricultural storage tanks per year.

Harvestore Construction was acquired in 1981 by Engineering America, one year after the incorporation of Engineering America. Andy became the Construction Operations Manager, and a member of the senior management team. He purchased shares in the company in 1993 and has been instrumental in growing its value thirteen-fold as of 2008. His current position is Vice President, Construction, and member of the Board of Directors.

Andy was born in South Dakota and graduated from Washington High School in Sioux Falls, SD. He has complemented his experience with construction management courses at the University of Minnesota.

Andy and his wife live in Zimmerman, MN. They have three adult sons and five granddaughters. Andy participated in hockey games all over the state, and he managed youth hockey.
